Grading rules

- The final grade is calculated by the formula

$$\text{final grade} = 0.7 \times (\text{cumulative grade}) + 0.3 \times (\text{exam grade}).$$

- The cumulative grade is calculated by the formula

$$\text{cumulative grade} = 0.5 \times (\text{midterm grade}) + 0.5 \times (\text{exercise sheets grade}).$$

- The oral exam will be at the end of December and will include only the material of the 2nd module.
- The midterm exam (also oral) will be at the end of October (or at the beginning of November) and will include only the material of the 1st module.
