Grading rules

• The final grade is calculated by the formula

final grade = $0.7 \times (\text{cumulative grade}) + 0.3 \times (\text{exam grade})$.

• The cumulative grade is calculated by the formula

cumulative grade = $0.5 \times (\text{midterm grade}) + 0.5 \times (\text{exercise sheets grade})$.
